DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT - There will be 7 major grandstand events held during The Linn County Fair this year. Volunteers are needed for each event for the following positions:

TICKET TAKERS – take pre-paid tickets for the event and direct the people to the area where wristbands will be attached. You may sit in a lawn chair to perform this duty.

ATTACHING WRISTBANDS – all ticket holders must have wristbands attached by volunteers. The wristband will allow them to enter and exit the grandstand during the event.

GRANDSTAND EXIT MONITORS- all ticket holders will initially enter the grandstand event through the main center entrance. If they wish to leave they must leave by the east (left of main entrance) or the west (right of main entrance). We will need two people at the top of the main entrance to direct those wishing to leave the grandstand before or during the event to the east or west exits. **THE MAIN ENTRANCE IS FOR INITIAL ENTRY ONLY.** It will be open to exiting when tickets are no longer being taken. You may use a lawn chair.

A male member of The Linn County Fair Association will be monitoring the east and west entrances to the grandstand. We would like at least one additional volunteer on each side to assist them. You will be monitoring people entering the grandstand that have a wristband already attached. Different colored wristbands will be used for each event, for beer tent admission, and for admission to the pit (in applicable events- such as tractor pull) and will you have to be aware of the differences. Anyone with a ticket in hand **MUST** be directed to enter through the main entrance. We have found that we have

less trouble if men are stationed at these particular entrances.
You may use a lawn chair.

DATES AND TIMES these are estimated times and may
change a little by fair time

July 10 (11 am – 2 pm) Draft Horse Pull

July 10 (6 pm- 9:30 pm) Truck & Tractor Pull

July 11 (5:30 pm – 8:30 pm) Chuck Wagon Races

July 12 (5:30 pm – 8 pm) Harness Racing

Ticket takers and monitors are free to enjoy the event after their duties are complete. All volunteers who work a total of four hours or more will be given a T-shirt that has the fair logo on the front and FRIEND OF THE FAIR on the back.
