

Details for All Vendors

- All Food Vendors need to send menu and picture of the food units due to some exclusions on food items.
- All vendors must have proof of insurance before anyone is allowed to set up.
- Commercial, Food, Home Based and Non Profits can start setting up any time after 9:00 a.m. Tuesday June 26th . Everyone must be set up by 9:00 p.m.. For special arrangements please contact Lori Arnold (319) 560-8297.

Recommended Hours for all Vendors to be open:

- **Wednesday June 27th 3:00 p.m. to close (Big Name Country Concert scheduled) this will be a free country concert**
- **Thursday – Sunday 10:00 a.m. Regular Vendors to 1 hour after grandstand event ends.**
- **Thursday – Sunday 11:00 a.m. Food Vendors to 1 hour after grandstand event ends.**
May open earlier if you wish to do so.
- ***Thursday (National Concert)***
- ***Friday (Nitty Gritty Dirt Band)***
- ***Also scheduled in the Grand Stand: Truck and Tractor Pull, Rodeo and Horse Pull.***
- **Monday- Optional hours available 5:00p.m. to end of grandstand event.**
- We encourage everyone to tie down tents, equipment and take merchandise with them after the grandstand events each evening. Security will be limited. The Linn County Fair Association is not responsible for any stolen or damaged items, including items damaged by mother nature.
- Tear down start is no earlier then ½ hour after granstand event on your last day and no later then midnight on Monday July 2nd.
- Trash must be placed in dumpsters located near the grandstand each night.
- You must provide your own tent, tables and chairs for outdoor vendor spaces and table and chairs for indoor.
- Indoor Vendor building will be locked ½ hour after the grandstand event ends.
- Vendor vehicle parking will be assigned when you check in. You must have Vendor parking pass to park on the fair grounds. Parking area to be determined at a later date.
- Food Vendors must have a Temporary Linn County Health Permit. Here is a link to there website www.linncounty.org/health on the right hand bottom click more forms. The documents you need for permit and guidelines #55 and #57 . The Linn County Health Department will be checking for correct documentation and doing inspections. - If your electrical power cords are in a high traffic area they must be covered for safety reasons.
